Green Screen how it works

Simply the set up for green screen involves a person or group standing in front of a green screen backdrop. The computer holds a library of backdrops to which the people are superimposed upon. This is not flat 2d as there are layers to create a decoupage 3d effect where the person is in the picture.

Where shall I use it

This system is limited in use only by the imagination; it can be used in any setting such as movie launches, theme parties or traditional black tie events.

The benefits of this attraction are that;

- It is full participation by the customers through poses and expression to be part of the set and introduces interest
- The real feel of being in the movie and a personal photograph of souvenir and personal value to keep and show to others.
- FOR EXAMPLE; "Thus for example we can use stills from a movie and using green screen superimpose people into the scene wearing accessories or holding light sabres, revolvers etc."

Output

The pictures can be delivered a few minutes and presented to guests in a theme presentation sleeve with brand and advertising details on the cover.

Digital presentations of the activity can be shown live on LCD screens for others to enjoy the action.

Further outputs can be made as slip in DVD box covers which contain trailers of the film or promotional DVDs of the film.

Cover Shot
